

Location of Kings Bromley Parish Mileposts

Adopted from Staffordshire County Council

County Highways have transferred ownership of the mileposts on the A513 and A515 within Kings Bromley Parish to Kings Bromley Parish Council.



The Milestone Society have a database, www.msocrepository.co.uk, which gives a reference number, grid reference, photograph and description of milestones in Kings Bromley Parish.

The Milestone on the A513 on the old manor wall, grid ref SK 109 168 is not included on the database, at least it does not come up on the search 'Kings Bromley Parish'

However the Milepost in Manor Road, and 3 Canal Markers on the Trent & Mersey Canal are included on the database.

Below are descriptions of the six adopted milestones, with new photographs taken 16/07/2018. The description of the milepost ST_TMST12 has been updated as the garage is no longer there and it was moved to its current location when the Co-op was built.

Milepost ST_TMST11 has recently been re-set and repainted by Howard Price of the Milestone Society.
David Smith of Common Lane kindly provided his JCB machine to lift and re-set it as a one off favour.

Howard Price of the Milestone Society writes the following:

The milepost marked- 'not surveyed' was restored in 2012 and it had been 'lost' amongst the undergrowth. It survives well against the wall. (photos attached at time of rescue and recovery). The one near the canal is a recent replacement casting (in 2006) after the original was struck by a car. The replacement is a faithful reproduction by Shenton's of Tipton who carry a pattern for the moulding. The decoration has not survived well. It is unusual for a Parish to have six milestones. There is one other Grade II listed turnpike era milestone along the old Manor road- beside the drive. It is a unique stone structure with a metal plate- not many people know of its existence:
