

## A38 Package of work scheme e-bulletin – w/c 22 June 2020

Welcome to this week's traffic management bulletin for the package of work that we're delivering on the A38.

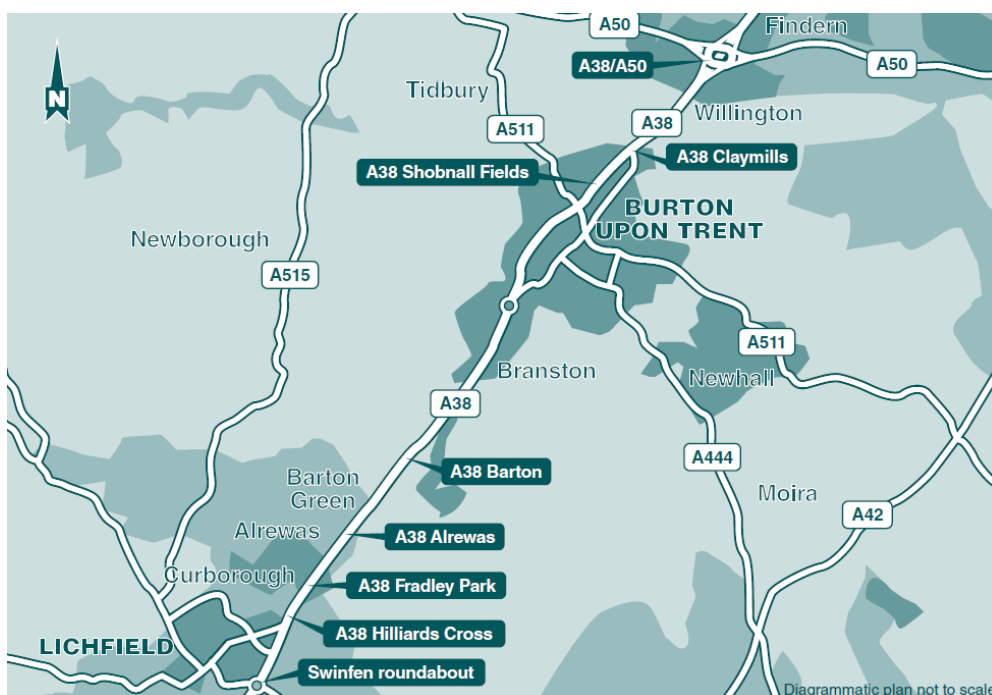
We are always looking for your feedback and have launched a website which allows you to have your say regarding our work and how we are communicating with you. Please follow the link [here](#).

While we have the northbound closures between Branston junction and Claymills junction in place we are going to complete some work replacing some of the vegetation. Some of the trees and vegetation aren't serving the purpose of screening the community from the A38. We will need to remove the leggy or potentially hazardous trees and we will be returning in the autumn to plant some evergreen species to improve the screening.

Restrictions in place 24/7 for the duration of the work:

- Narrow lanes in place on the southbound A38 through Barton Turn and the 50mph speed limits are being enforced via speed camera.
- On the local road above the A38 at Barton Turn (B5016/Station Road) 3-way traffic lights in operation to allow us to work on our repairs to the bridge.
