Welcome to this week's traffic management bulletin for the package of work that we're delivering on the A38.

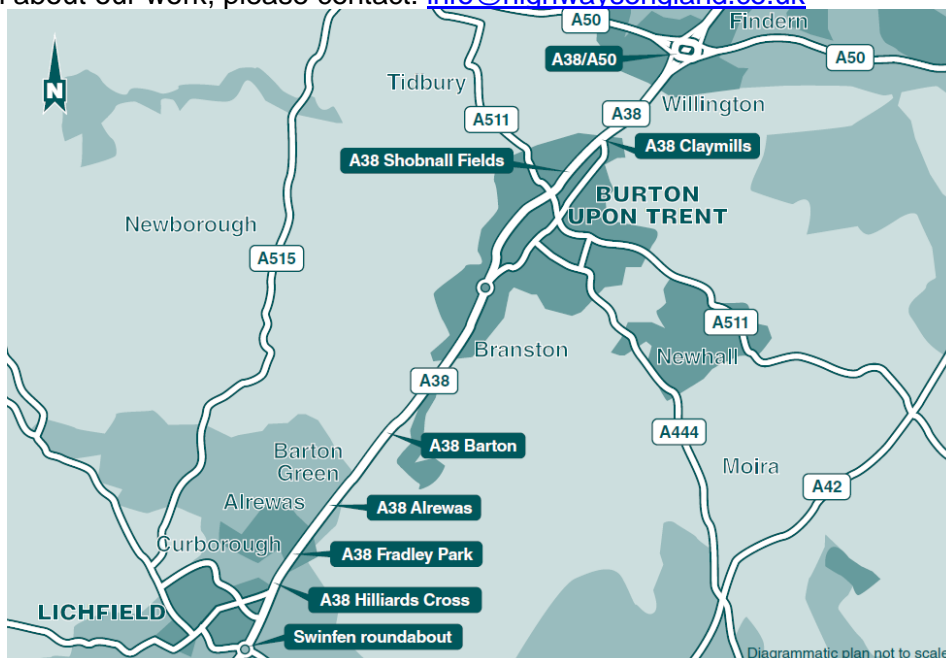
This week we have been completed the road markings for Swinfen roundabout where we also completed pothole repairs and other general maintenance. We also managed to repair some cracking in the surface of the A38 between Weeford roundabout and Swinfen roundabout using the same closure. The next few weeks sees our focus switch to drainage repairs between Branston junction and Claymills junction (Shobnall Fields on the map below).

We were due to reduce the A38 exit slip at Toyota to a single lane but this work has now been postponed. I will let you know when we plan to start the work.

Restrictions in place 24/7 for the duration of the work:

- Narrow lanes in place on the southbound A38 through Barton Turn and the 50mph speed limits are being enforced via speed camera.
- On the local road above the A38 at Barton Turn (B5016/Station Road) 3-way traffic lights in operation to allow us to work on our repairs to the bridge.
