Welcome to this week's traffic management bulletin for the package of work that we're delivering on the A38.

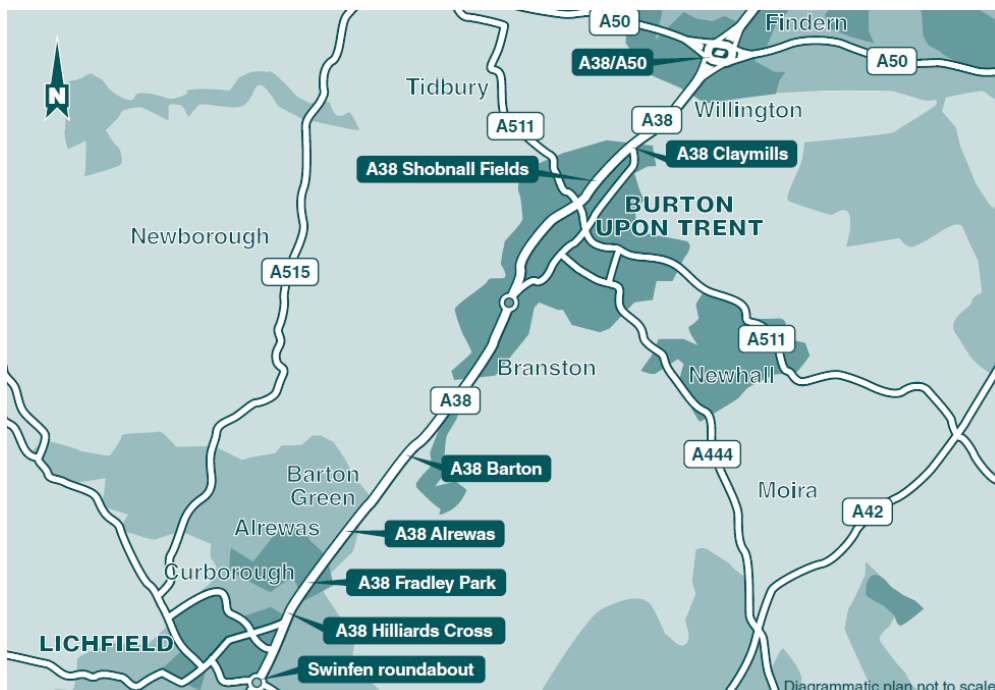
We are always looking for your feedback and have launched a website which allows you to have your say regarding our work and how we are communicating with you. Please follow the link [here](#).

We're continuing to improve the drainage on the A38 between Branston junction and claymills junction. We're also going to start some work on the land slide issues on the northbound exit slip at Toyota Island (A50). To complete our work there we'll be reducing the slip road to a single lane 24/7 from 28 July until the work is complete.

Restrictions in place 24/7 for the duration of the work:

- Narrow lanes in place on the southbound A38 through Barton Turn and the 50mph speed limits are being enforced via speed camera.
- On the local road above the A38 at Barton Turn (B5016/Station Road) 3-way traffic lights in operation to allow us to work on our repairs to the bridge.
