

A38 Package of work scheme e-bulletin – w/c 6 July 2020

Welcome to this week's traffic management bulletin for the package of work that we're delivering on the A38.

We are always looking for your feedback and have launched a website which allows you to have your say regarding our work and how we are communicating with you. Please follow the link here.

Things to note this week are:

- the B5016 will be closed for 1 night on Friday 10 July to reconfigure the traffic management on the bridge over the A38
- the A38 will be closed southbound on Sunday 12 July between Branston and Alrewas to repair some kerb damaged following a traffic accident

Restrictions in place 24/7 for the duration of the work:

- Narrow lanes in place on the southbound A38 through Barton Turn and the 50mph speed limits are being enforced via speed camera.
- On the local road above the A38 at Barton Turn (B5016/Station Road) 3-way traffic lights in operation to allow us to work on our repairs to the bridge.
