Welcome to this week's traffic management bulletin for the package of work that we're delivering on the A38.

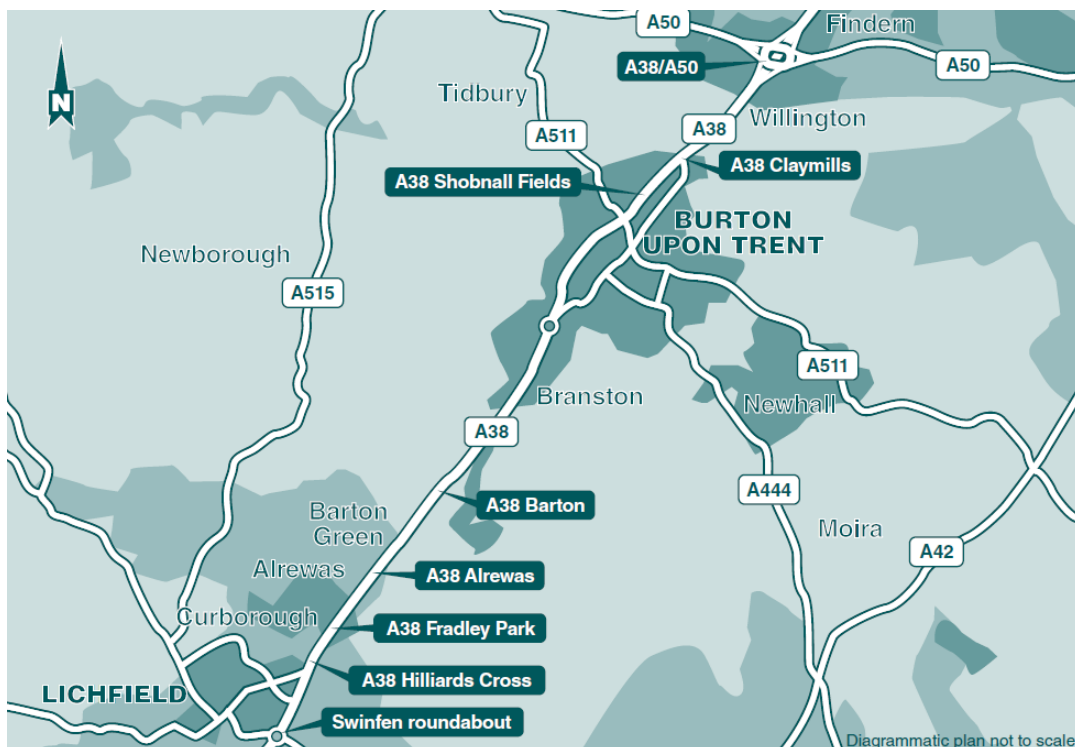
This is the last week for you to give your feedback via our commonplace website. This allows you to have your say regarding our work and how we are communicating with you. Please follow the link [here](#).

We have no planned closures in place for the A38 in the next 2 weeks. We will continue our work on the bridge repairs at Barton Turn and on the Toyota island northbound exit slip road within the existing traffic management.

Restrictions in place 24/7 for the duration of the work:

- Narrow lanes in place on the southbound A38 through Barton Turn and the 50mph speed limits are being enforced via speed camera.
- On the local road above the A38 at Barton Turn (B5016/Station Road) 3-way traffic lights in operation to allow us to work on our repairs to the bridge.
- A38 northbound exit slip road to A50 reduced to one lane.
