Welcome to this week's traffic management bulletin for the package of work that we're delivering on the A38.


We are always looking for your feedback and have launched a website which allows you to have your say regarding our work and how we are communicating with you. Please follow the link <u>here</u>.

This week we have no closures for our drainage improvements between Claymills junction and Branston junction. We now need to change the layout of the scaffolding to allow us to reach the next stage of our bridge repairs at Barton Turn. To enable us to do this we will need to close the A38 southbound between Branston and Alrewas for 2 nights this week. The diversion route is shown below.

Restrictions in place 24/7 for the duration of the work:

- Narrow lanes in place on the southbound A38 through Barton Turn and the 50mph speed limits are being enforced via speed camera.
- On the local road above the A38 at Barton Turn (B5016/Station Road) 3-way traffic lights in operation to allow us to work on our repairs to the bridge.
- A38 northbound exit slip road to A50 reduced to one lane.

We're sorry for any disruption that our work may cause you; please plan and allow extra time for your journey.
