

## A38 Package of work scheme e-bulletin – w/c 9 November 2020

Welcome to this week's traffic management bulletin for the package of work that we're delivering on the A38.

We plan to start our second weekend of closures of the A38 southbound within the Claymills junction to replace the safety barrier from Friday 13 November 8pm to Monday 16 November 6am. The diversion route is to come off the A38 southbound on the exit slip road and to use the entry slip to rejoin. Please see the diversion map below.


From 16 November we will start removing the narrow lanes that are in place on the A38 southbound carriageway through the Barton Turns structure. We'll need to remove the narrow lane configuration, realign and resurface the carriageway, replace safety barrier and remark the lines and reflective studs. We'll close the A38 both southbound and northbound on different days to allow us to complete the work. This should 2 weeks to complete.

We won't close the A38 in both directions at the same time.

Restrictions in place 24/7 for the duration of the work:

- Narrow lanes in place on the southbound A38 through Barton Turn and the 50mph speed limits are being enforced via speed camera.
- On the local road above the A38 at Barton Turn (B5016) 30mph speed limit in place.
- A38 northbound exit slip road to A50 reduced to one lane.
