

A38 Package of work scheme e-bulletin – w/c 19 July 2021

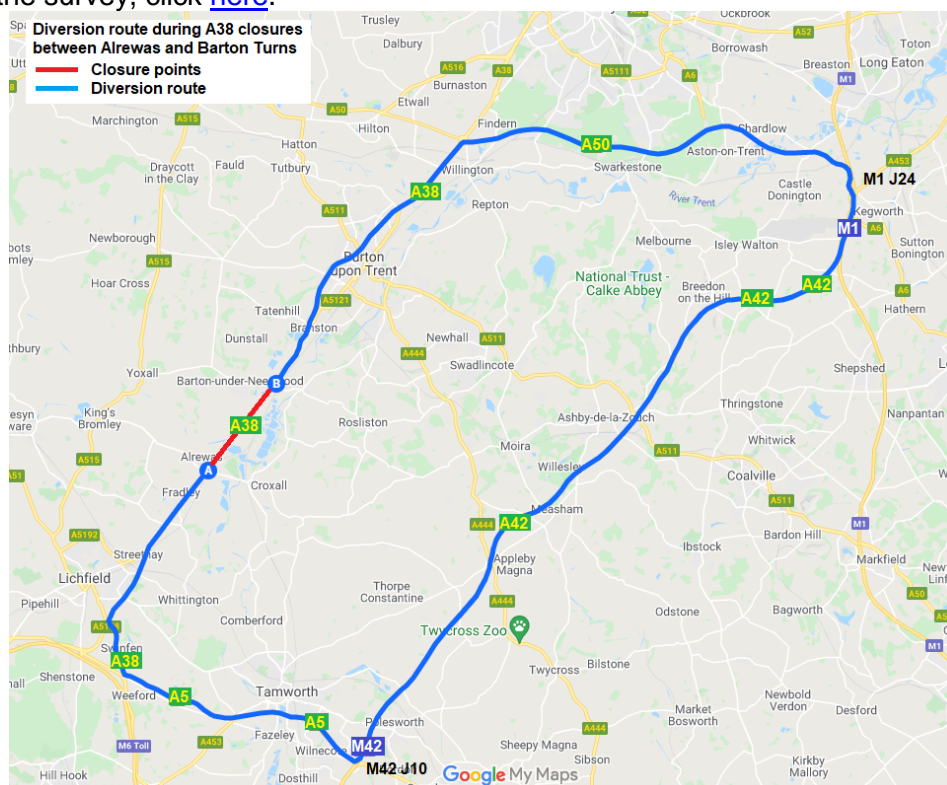
Welcome to this week's traffic management bulletin for the package of work that we're delivering on the A38.

From 26 July we have work planned to remove a redundant layby and to install new safety barrier. We'll also be working on replacing drain covers and removing potentially hazardous trees. This work will continue until 8 August, before a short pause due to other work in the West Midlands. Our final phase will be from 31 August until 15 September.

We're looking to use an alternative diversion route to the one previously used (please see map below). The route is slightly longer but by staying on the Strategic Road Network it is only a few minutes longer than the original diversion. This will help reduce the impact of the diversion on the local road network.
