Welcome to this week's traffic management bulletin for the package of work that we're delivering on the A38.

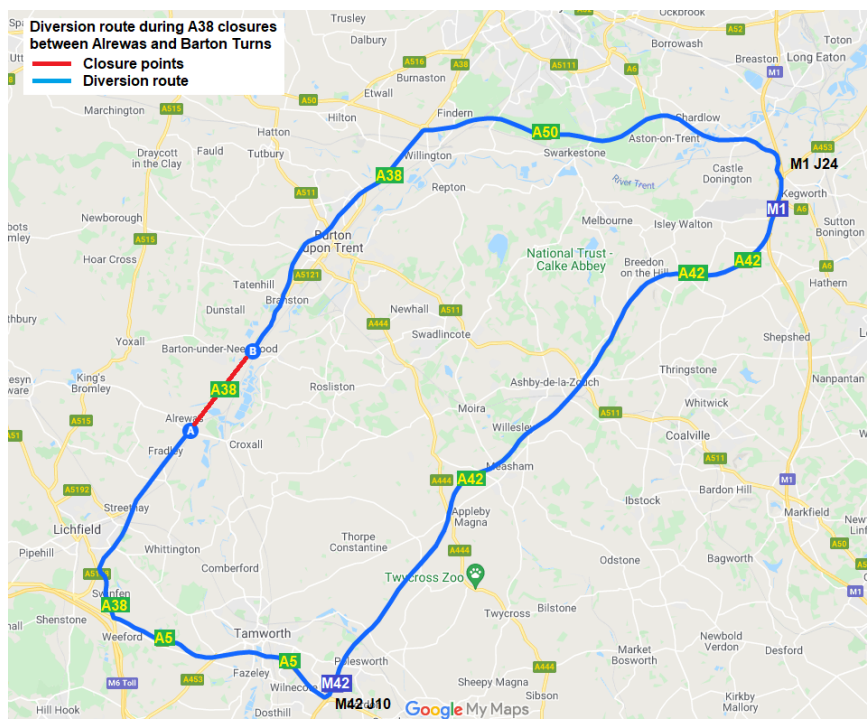
This week we are starting our work on the southbound carriageway between Barton Turns junction and Alrewas junction to complete barrier and carriageway repairs.

From Monday 27 September we'll continue our work on the southbound carriageway between Barton Turns junction and Alrewas junction. We will also carry out work to the barrier on the northbound carriageway between Cappers Lane and Wood End Lane.

During the closures we'll be utilising the alternative diversion route that was in place earlier in the month (please see map below). This will help reduce the impact of the diversion on the local road network.
