

A38 Package of work scheme e-bulletin – w/c 25 October 2021

Welcome to this week's traffic management bulletin for the package of work that we're delivering on the A38.


This week, from Monday 25 October, there will be a lane closure on the A38 northbound and southbound at Toyota Island whilst we carry out ground investigations.

We're planning to upgrade the lighting along the A38 between Toyota roundabout and Catholme. The new LED lighting will be more energy efficient and will require less maintenance. We'll start our work on Monday 1 November and expect to finish by the end of February 2022. We'll be working between 8pm and 6am, 5 days a week, and will work in multiple phases to reduce the impact on road users and the local economy. During the work, we'll need to close sections of the A38 overnight at various locations. Road signs will be in place ahead of any closures and we'll provide updates, or advise of any changes to this work weekly through this bulletin.

We're sorry for any disruption that our work may cause you; please plan and allow extra time for your journey.
