

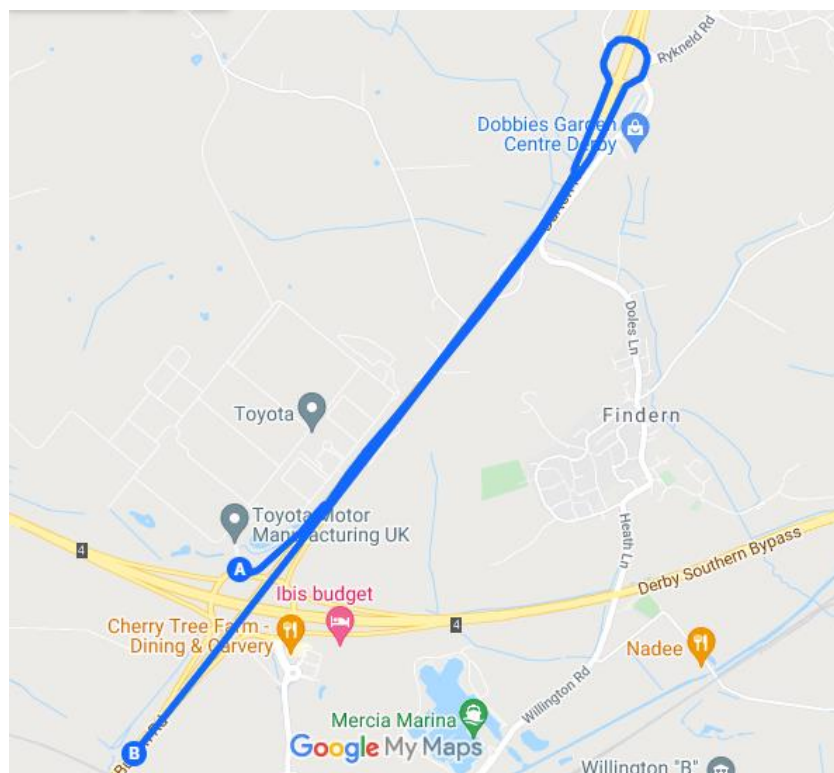
A38 Package of work e-bulletin – w/c 27 December 2021
