

A38 Lichfield to Toyota Island weekly e-bulletin w/c 11 September 2023

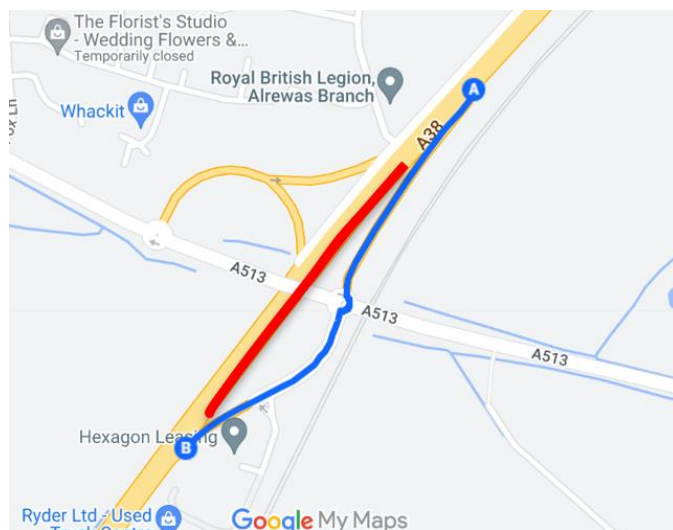
Welcome to this week's traffic management bulletin for the package of work that National Highways is delivering on the A38 between Lichfield and Toyota Island in Derby.

Until 16 September, on weeknights from 8pm to 6am, there will be full closures of the A38 northbound between the Hilliard's Cross junction and the Branston junction. Then, from 18 September until 29 September, on weeknights from 8pm to 6am, we'll switch back to full closures of the **A38 southbound** between the Branston junction and the Hilliard's Cross junction as we continue our A38 Fradley to Barton maintenance scheme. During these closures, we'll carry out safety barrier replacement, street lighting, drainage and other maintenance works. To maintain safety throughout, a reduced speed limit of 40mph will be in place along with speed enforcement.

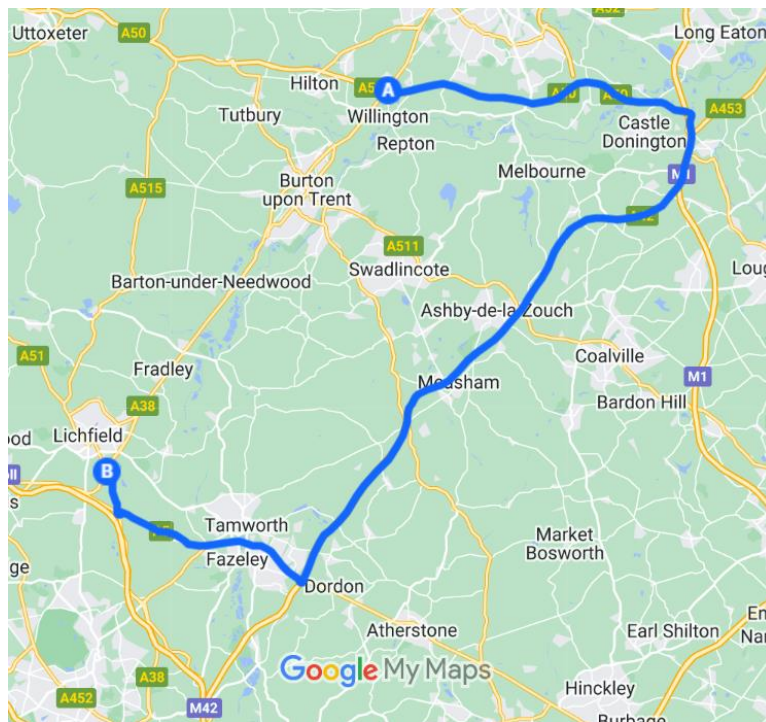
Please see the below diversion for these closures.

Until 16 September, there will be a full closure, 24/7, of the Rykneld Street and Burton Road service road at the Alrewas junction. During these closures, we'll carry out safety barrier replacement, street lighting, drainage and other maintenance works. Access to homes, frontages and emergency services vehicles will be maintained throughout the work. However, there may be times when access is delayed for safety reasons, but we'll make every effort to ensure any delays are kept to a minimum.

From 8pm on Friday 22 September, to 6am on Monday 25 September, we'll have a full weekend closure of the A38 southbound between the slip roads at the Alrewas/A513 junction. During this closure we will replace the safety barrier underneath the bridge. Please see the below picture which has the closure marked in red, and during this time we'll install a short 'up and over' diversion which is marked in blue.

Northbound traffic – traffic to take A38 from Swinfen Interchange and join the A5 eastbound from Weeford Interchange. Continue on the A5 to M42 roundabout. At the roundabout, join the M42 at junction 10 heading north. Remain on M42/A42 as it merges with the M1 junction 23a. Traffic to exit M1 at junction 24 and head towards the A50 westbound. Remain on A50 to A38 Toyota Island.

Southbound traffic – traffic to take A50 eastbound from Toyota Island and continue to M1 junction 24a. Head south on M1 to junction 23a and merge on to M42/A42. Remain on M42/A42 until reaching M42 junction 10 and take the exit. At the roundabout, join A5 westbound to Weeford Interchange and then continue north on A38 to Swinfen Interchange.
