

A38 Lichfield to Toyota Island weekly e-bulletin w/c 4 March 2024

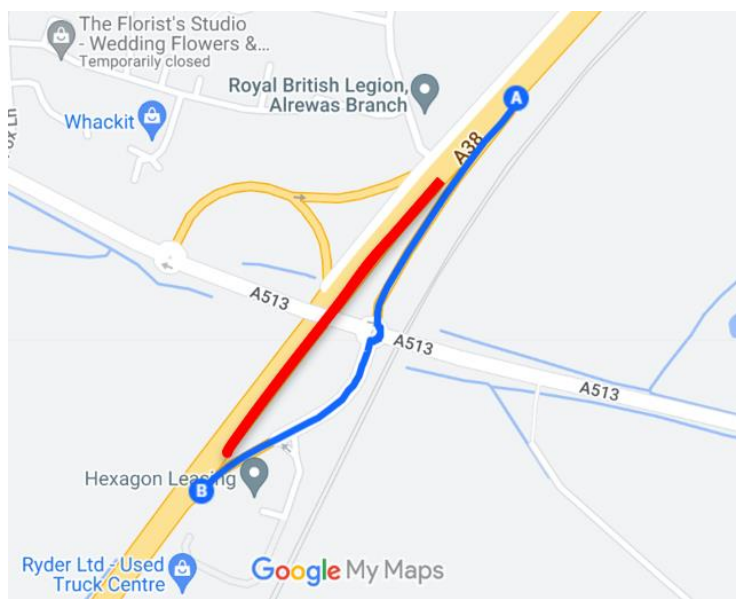
Welcome to this week's traffic management bulletin for the package of work that National Highways is delivering on the A38 between Lichfield and Toyota Island in Derby.

Over the coming weeks, we'll be returning to complete the outstanding work of the A38 Fradley to Barton combined maintenance scheme. Our work will include safety barrier repairs, lighting upgrades and replacing signs.

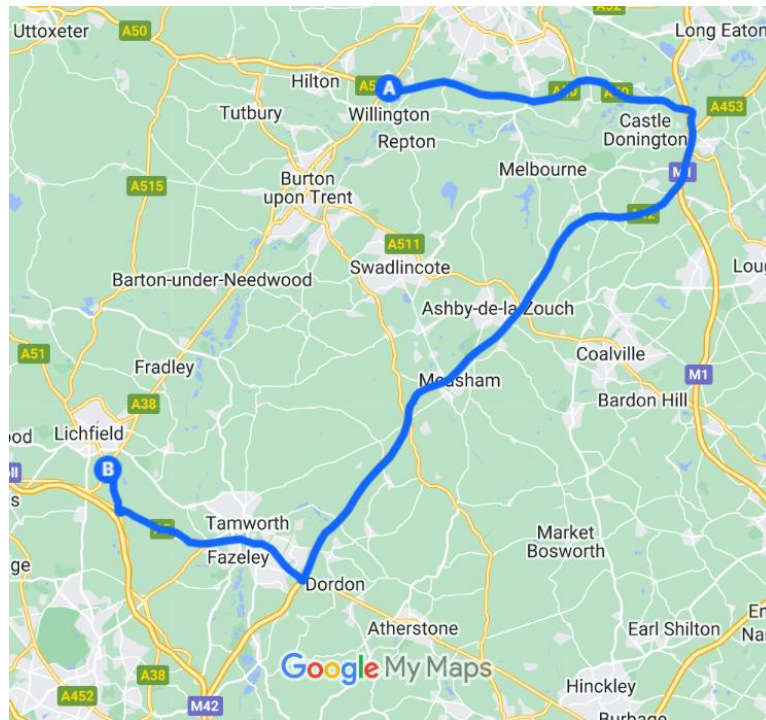
From Monday 11 March to Thursday 14 March, overnight from 8pm to 6am, we'll have full closures of the A38 southbound, between the Branston junction and Hilliards Cross junction. During these times, there will be a single lane closure in place on the A38 northbound of this section.

Please see the below diversion for these closures.

From 8pm on Friday 15 March to 6am on Monday 18 March, we will have a 24/7 closure of the A38 southbound carriageway, between the slip roads of the A513 junction (Alrewas junction), to allow us to replace the safety barrier under the A513 bridge. Please see the below picture which shows the closure in red and the diversion in blue:

Southbound traffic – traffic to take A50 eastbound from Toyota Island and continue to M1 junction 24a. Head south on M1 to junction 23a and merge on to M42/A42. Remain on M42/A42 until reaching M42 junction 10 and take the exit. At the roundabout, join A5 westbound to Weeford Interchange and then continue north on A38 to Swinfen Interchange.
