

A38 Lichfield to Toyota Island weekly e-bulletin w/c 13 May 2024

Welcome to this week's traffic management bulletin for the package of work that National Highways is delivering on the A38 between Lichfield and Toyota Island in Derby.

We've almost finished our work on the A38 Fradley to Barton combined maintenance scheme. We'll need to return in May to complete some final work, which will need two nights of closures in each direction as follows:

16 and 17 May 2024 – full overnight closures, from 8pm to 6am, of the A38 **northbound** between the Hilliard's Cross junction and Barton Turns junction.

20 and 21 May 2024 - full overnight closures, from 8pm to 6am, of the A38 **southbound** between the Branston junction and Alrewas junction.

We'll be continuing our A38 Toyota to Mickleover maintenance scheme. During this work we'll be repairing the safety barrier in the central reservation along the A38 between Toyota Island and Mickleover. We'll also be carrying out vegetation clearance and grass cutting along this section.

Until 17 May, on weeknights from 8pm to 6am, we'll have full southbound carriageway closures from A516 Mickleover junction to Toyota Island. A northbound lane 2 closure will be in place during these times.

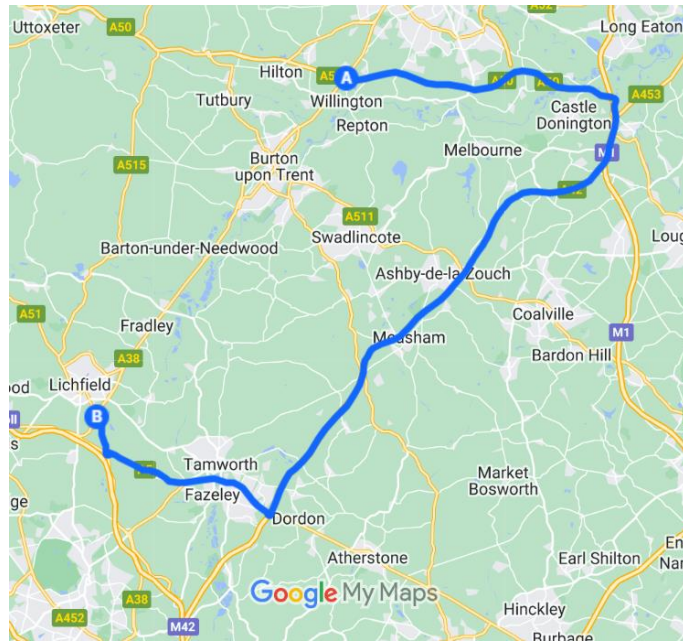
From 20 May to 7 June, we'll have lane closures on the northbound carriageway between Toyota Island and the A516 Mickleover junction.

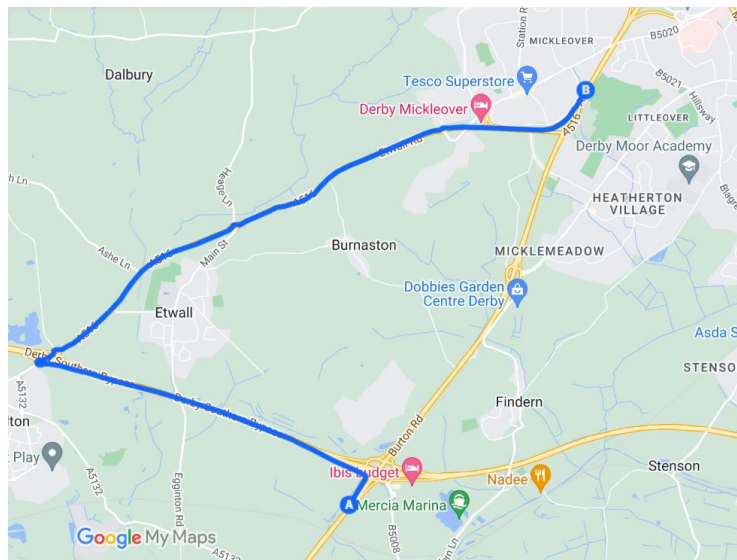
