

A38 Lichfield to Toyota Island weekly e-bulletin w/c 9 September 2024

Welcome to this week's traffic management bulletin for the package of work that National Highways is delivering on the A38 between Lichfield and Toyota Island in Derby.

A38/A50 Toyota Island essential maintenance

Until the end of November, we'll be carrying out maintenance work at the A38/A50 Toyota Island. This work is to the repaint sections of the bridge, which runs over the A38 on the A50 Toyota Island, and is essential to protect and prevent rusting to the existing structure. This work will be completed under a combination of 24/7 lane closures and overnight full carriageway closures as follows:

24/7 lane closures

- **9 September to 29 November**, A38 southbound lane 2 closed, 24/7.

Overnight full carriageway closures

- **9 September to 29 November**, between **8pm and 5am** - weekday overnight closures of the A38 southbound, between the exit and entry slip at Toyota Island. During this time there will also be a lane 2 closure of the northbound carriageway here.

During closures, a small diversion will be installed over Toyota Island using the exit and entry slips. For the duration of the works, 50mph restrictions will be in place.
